An opening is available for a highly motivated postdoctoral fellow with a background in immunology and an interest in studying dendritic cells in the laboratory of Dr. Idoyaga (<http://idoyagalab.stanford.edu>) in the Department of Microbiology and Immunology at Stanford University.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will join the lab to characterize dendritic cells and microbiome during skin cancer development, at the molecular and functional level utilizing CyTOF and RNAseq, among other techniques.

The applicant must have, or be nearing completion of, a PhD or MD/PhD, be self-motivated, have excellent oral and written communication skills, ability to work independently as well as cooperatively with a team, a strong immunology background, competence in animal handling, experience working with flow cytometry, primary cell isolation and computational. Experience working with dendritic cells is desirable.
